Am I | Are we

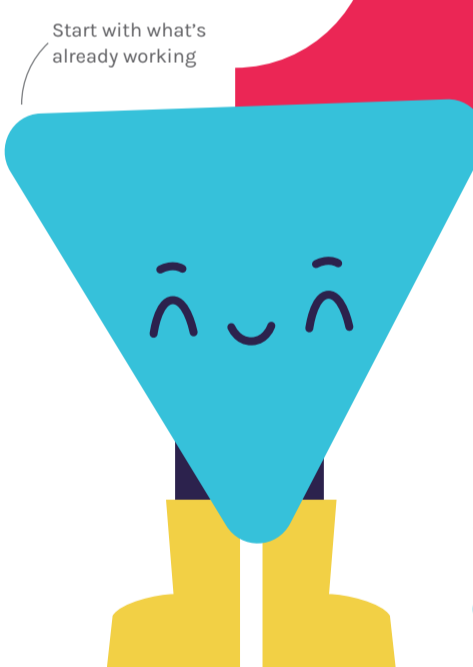
- Amplifying and being led by marginalised voices?
